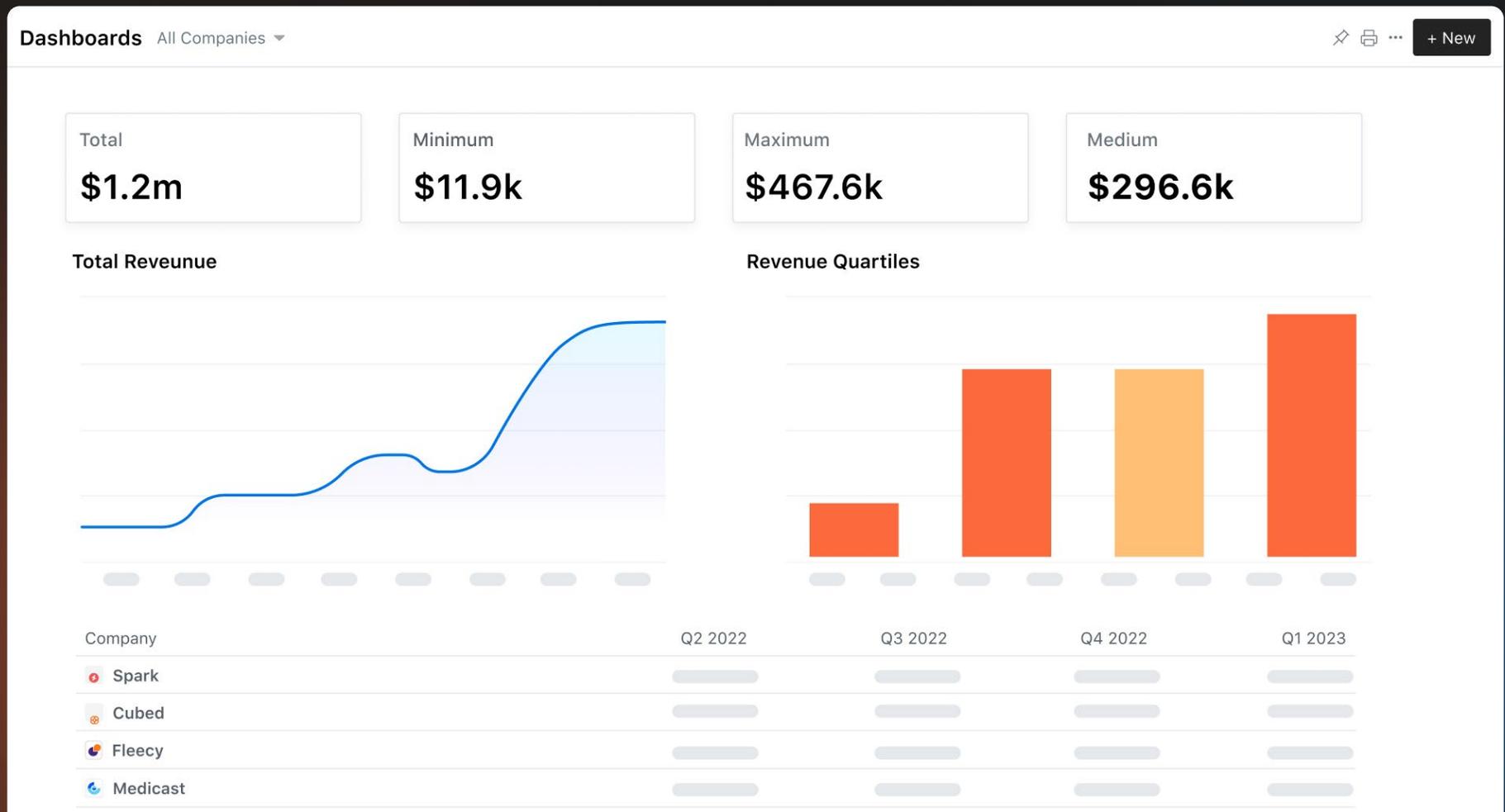

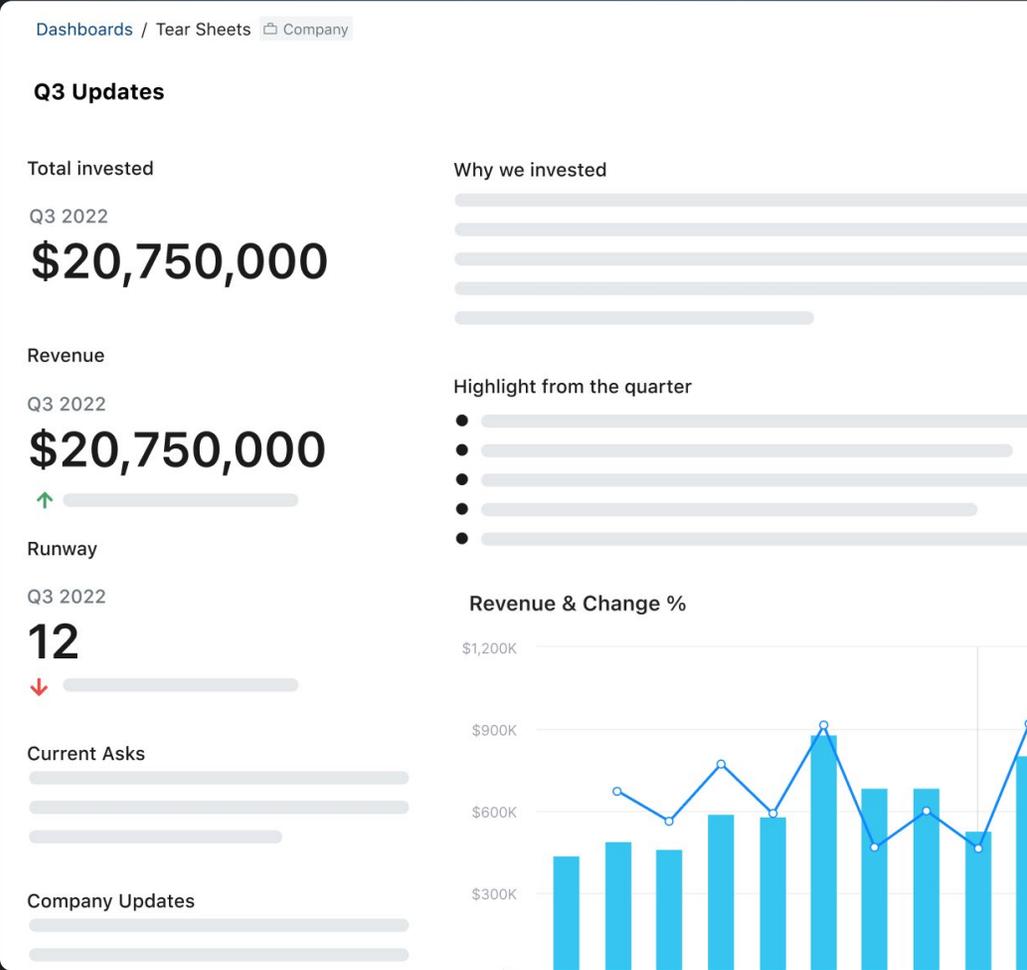

# Portfolio Data Collection Best Practices

Why are VC's Collecting Data?

It's common for Venture Capital investors to collect structured data from their portfolio companies on a regular basis. About ~70% of investors on Visible are collecting data on a quarterly basis.

VC's collect data from their companies so they can:

- Provide better portfolio support
- Make data-driven investment decisions
- Validate markups and markdowns during valuation exercises
- Demonstrate traction while fundraising for future funds

# The Importance of Data-driven Portfolio Review Meetings

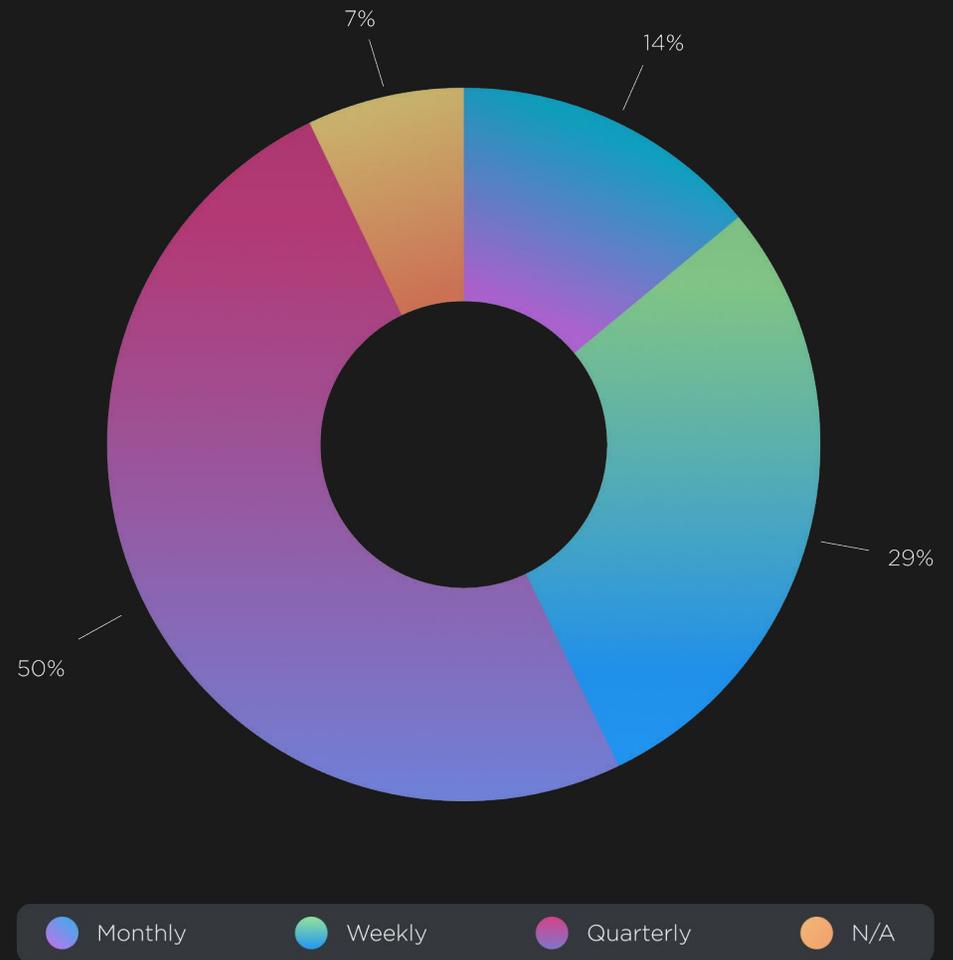
## What is an Internal Portfolio Review Meeting?

Internal portfolio review meetings are a great way for firms to align on recent updates from portfolio companies. Oftentimes, workflows at VC firms are siloed based on whether you're a part of the investment team or the operations team. Portfolio review meetings are used to get everyone on the same page and to surface insights that can inform portfolio support or investment decisions.

The frequency of internal portfolio review meetings depends on the size of your portfolio and the size of your team.

Based on a poll from a Visible webinar, 50% of VC firms host portfolio review meetings on a quarterly basis.

# Using Dashboards to Facilitate Portfolio Reviews

## How to create an engaging dashboard

1. Choose from 5 different widget types:

**Charts:** Great for KPI visualizations

**Tables:** Often used to pull in investment data

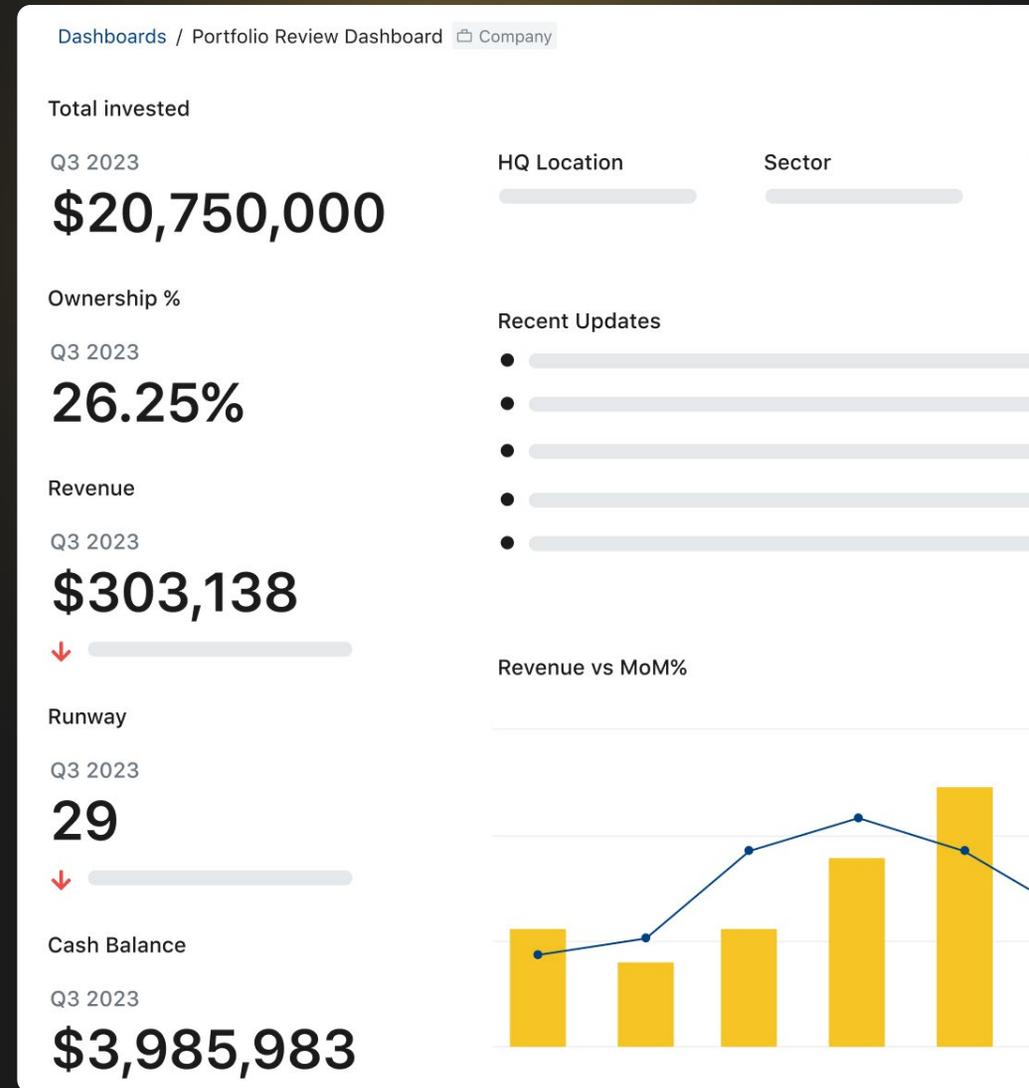
**Properties:** Integrates with a company's profile

**Text:** To include qualitative updates about companies

**Variance reports:** To show budgets vs actuals

2. Resize widgets and re-arrange until you land on your ideal format.

3. Save as a template and apply to all your companies

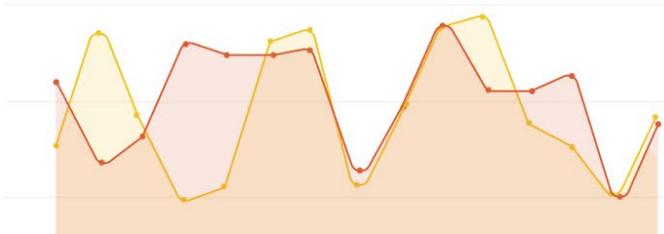

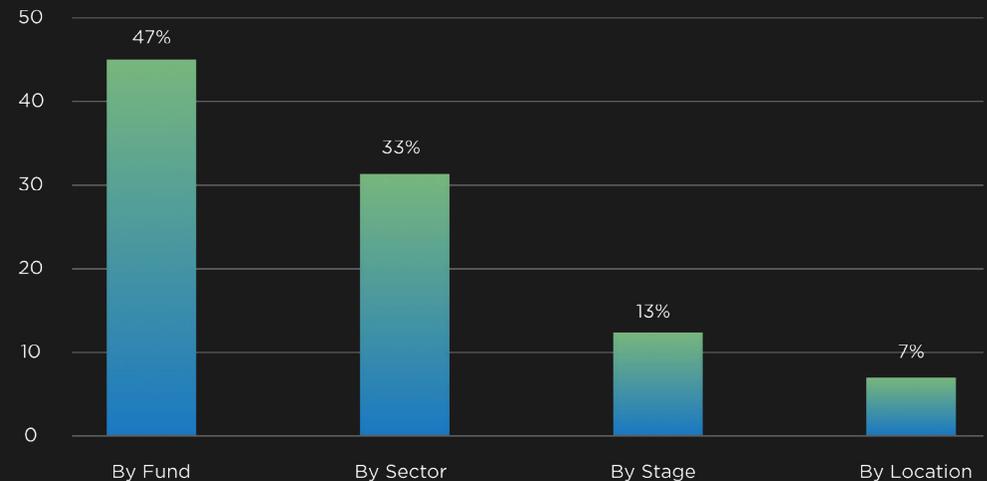

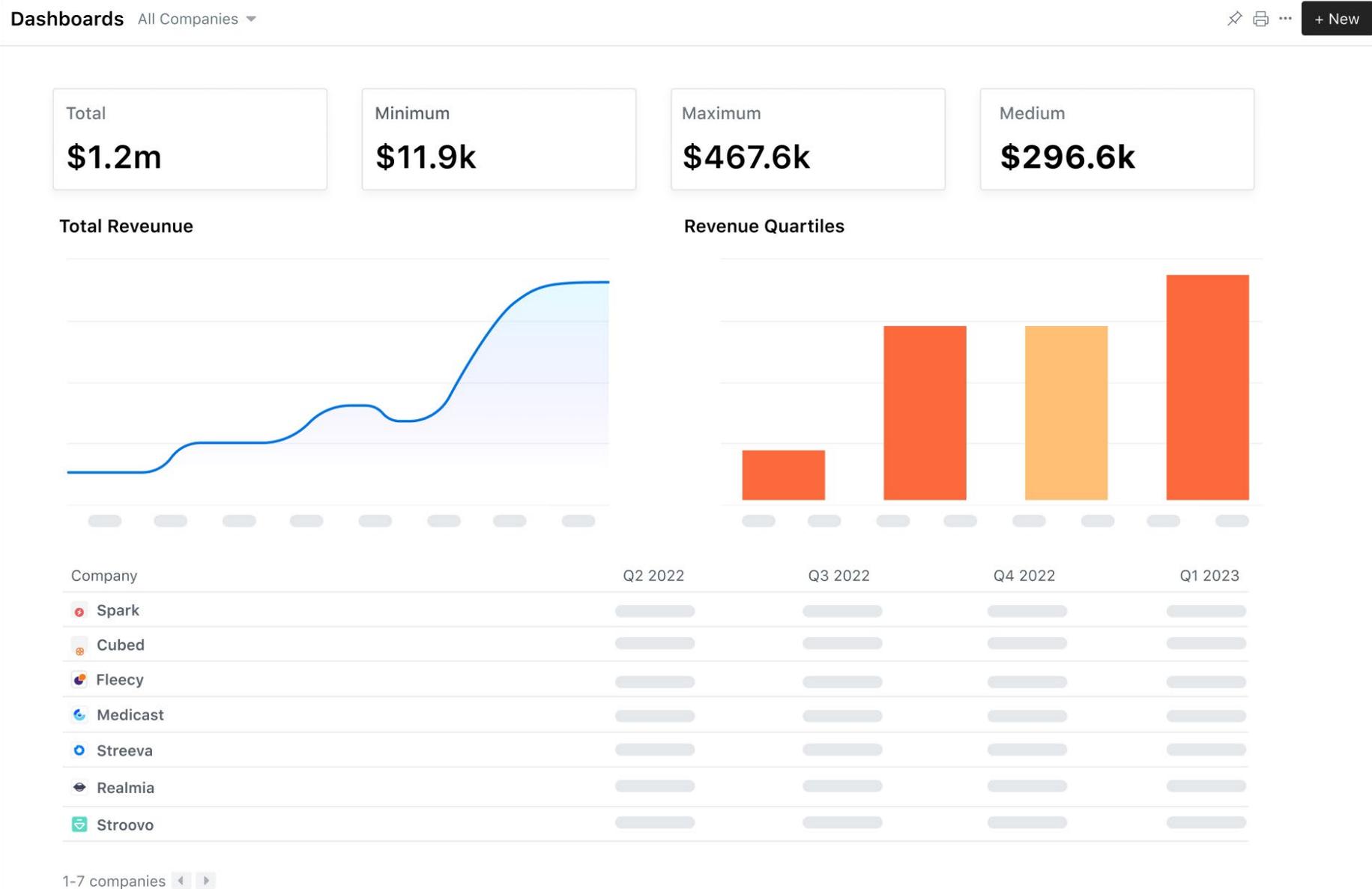
## Filtering your Data Visualizations

# Keeping LPs Engaged with One Pagers

## What to Include in a One Pager

One Pagers, also known as Tear Sheets, are easy-to-digest updates about portfolio companies prepared for Limited Partners typically on a quarterly basis.

## Common sections to include in a One Pager:

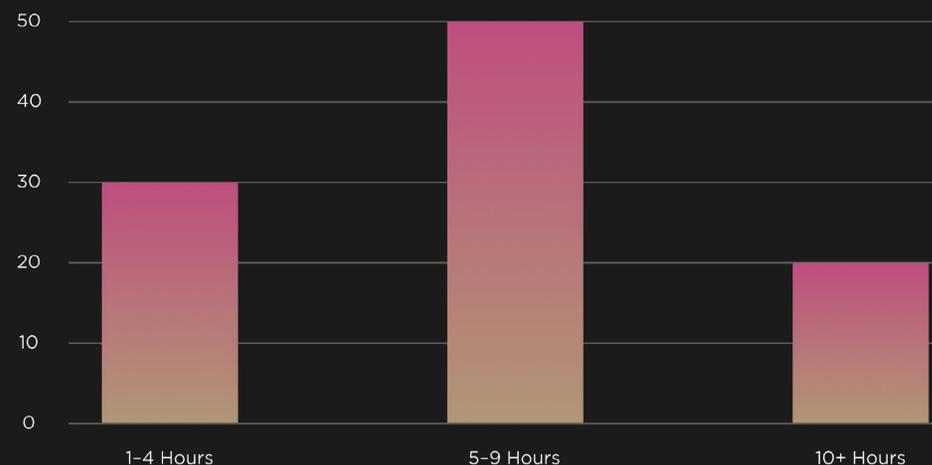
- Metrics: Revenue, Headcount, Truth North KPI's
- Company properties: Sector, HQ location, company tagline
- Qualitative sections: Why we invested, recent updates, Asks
- Investment Data: Total invested, investment data, multiple, ownership percentage.
